Ridgway is pleased to be able to offer the opportunity for your child to attend school camp at Forest Lakes in Otaki.

The aim of this camp: Is to provide our Year 5 and 6 students with adventurous outdoor activities that will foster independence and develop their personal, social and physical skills while being active and safe in the outdoors.

The various outdoor activities that our students will participate in will challenge them to cooperate, solve problems, make decisions, overcome challenges, set goals, communicate, lead, reflect and assume responsibility.

The activities on this camp contain risks. The school and camp staff, with the support of our parent helpers, will manage risk and hazards according to the school's and camp's safety management plans.

Due to the greater associated risk with those activities in the 1 ½ hour rotations on Monday and Tuesday, these activities require 2 adults supervising them who have been briefed by the Forest Lakes Staff. Horse riding and kayaking are instructed by the Forest Lakes Staff with the assistance of our adult helpers.

While risks can be maintained to acceptable levels they cannot be totally eliminated. Some risk is retained for its learning and experiential value. If you wish to see our Risk Analysis Management Plans for these activities and

Forest Lake's Guidelines for Supervisors outlining their safety protocols, feel free to read these via the link on our school website.

"Camp Consent," "Camp Health and Medical" and "Forest Lakes Risk Disclosure and Acknowledgement" forms are attached with this letter, please read and sign these forms and return to the school office no later than Friday 16 February.

Also attached is an equipment list. If there are items on the gear list that you do not have, please let your child's homegroup teacher know as we may be able to source it for you.

Cabins: Students will have input into who they would like to share a cabin with. Girls and boys will be sleeping in different cabin blocks and are not allowed in each others areas. Each cabin will have an adult "Camp mother or father" to look after them. Adults will not be sleeping in cabins with children but will be nearby should children need them.

Behaviour: At school and at camp we encourage and manage behaviour in accordance with our Positive Behaviour for Learning programme which is centred on our 4R's - Respect, Resilience, Responsibility and Resourcefulness. It is important for safety reasons that students follow instructions given to them by all staff and follow all appropriate school rules. Behaviour by students that is deemed dangerous and puts themselves and/or others at undue risk will result in students being removed from that activity and potentially the camp.

Cost: If you agree to your child attending, the cost of this experience will be \$150.00. This money will need to be paid to the school, prior to your child going to camp. Fundraising efforts in 2017 have gone towards reducing the costs of this camp.

Families may wish to start making regular payments now towards the Camp. If you are paying by internet banking or automatic payment, please put your child's name as a reference and Camp as the code.
